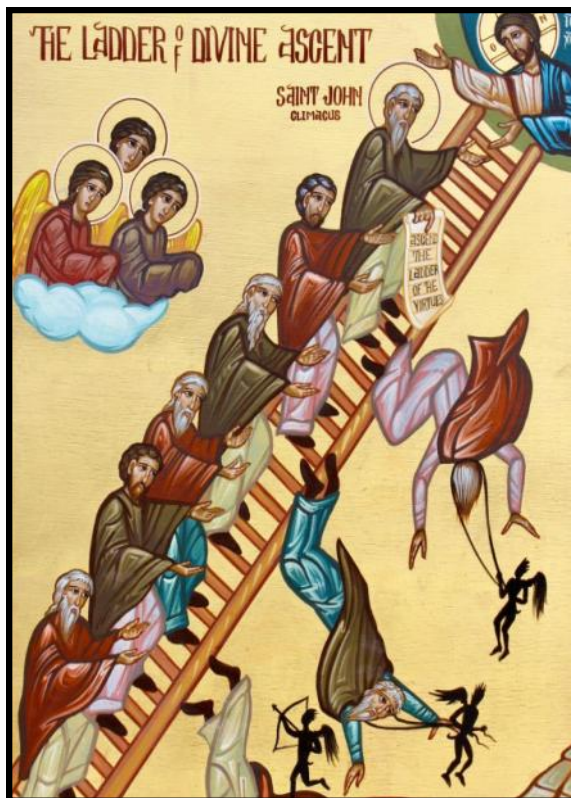

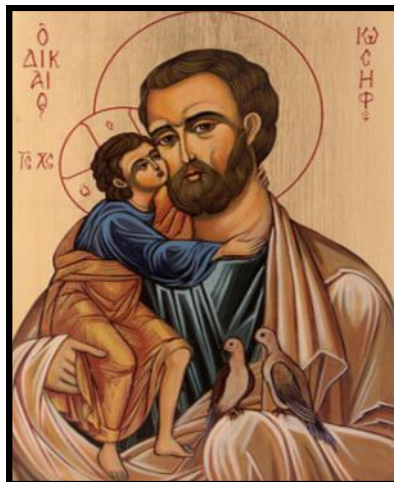

The Year of St. Joseph

On December 8, 1870, The Sacred Congregation of Rites promulgated a decree, which communicated the decision of Pope Pius IX to declare St. Joseph the Patron of the Universal Church.

The Vatican announced that this year, December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021 would be a year dedicated to St. Joseph, husband of Mary and earthly father of Jesus Christ.



Because of this noble dignity that God conferred on His most faithful servant, the Church has always honoured and acclaimed Joseph next to his spouse, the Blessed Mother of God and has implored his intercession in times of strife and unrest.

The Holy Father, Pope Francis urged Catholics to turn to St. Joseph in times of adversity. “Always invoke him, especially in difficult times and entrust your life to this Great Saint by praying:

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin. To you God entrusted His only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man. Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide to us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage and defend us from every evil. Amen.”

As we witness the social upheaval in our time; the uprisings; the racial tensions; the injustices and the moral decay, it is of most importance that we emulate the role model and sanctity of St. Joseph. We pray that this year will bring renewal and rejuvenation to our Churches and help each one of us grow in holiness by imitating the life of St. Joseph.
