How Jesus dealt with prejudice in several ways

1. Breaking societal norms: Jesus often challenged the prevailing social norms and customs of his time. He interacted with marginalized groups, such as tax collectors, Samaritans, and women, who were often discriminated against or looked down upon by society.

2. Teaching equality and love for all: Jesus consistently emphasized the importance of loving one's neighbor and treating others with kindness and compassion. He taught that every person is made in the image of God and deserves equal respect and dignity, regardless of their background or social status.

3. Addressing hypocrisy and discrimination: Jesus openly criticized the religious leaders of his time for their hypocrisy and discriminatory practices. He condemned their judgmental attitudes and called for a genuine love and acceptance of others.

4. Healing and restoration: Jesus frequently healed individuals who were marginalized or considered outcasts by society, such as lepers, the blind, and the disabled. By doing so, he demonstrated that no one should be excluded or treated differently based on their physical or social condition.

5. Parables and teachings: Jesus used parables and teachings to challenge prejudice and promote equality. For example, the parable of the Good Samaritan emphasized the importance of showing love and compassion to all, regardless of their ethnic or cultural background.

6. Leading by example: Jesus consistently modeled inclusivity and acceptance in his own interactions with people. He welcomed everyone, regardless of their past or current circumstances, and treated them with kindness and respect.

7. Forgiveness and reconciliation: Jesus taught the importance of forgiveness and reconciliation, even towards those who had wronged him or held prejudiced views. He demonstrated forgiveness through his interactions with individuals like Zacchaeus, a tax collector, and the woman caught in adultery.

Jesus' approach to prejudice was rooted in love, compassion, and a desire for equality and justice. He consistently challenged societal norms, advocated for the marginalized, and taught his followers to treat others with respect and acceptance.
